Kusamakura Onsen Tensui 草枕温泉てんすい 511-1 Oama Tensuimachi, Tamana

Enjoy the view of the Ariake Sea and Shimabara Peninsula from Oama Onsen on top of the hill. The breathtaking view of the sunset from the outdoor bath is especially spectacular from November to February. There is a restaurant and market in the facility that sells special local produce and fresh local vegetables and fruits



Tensui Orange Road 天水オレンジロード

Tensui Orange Road is Tamana's agricultural road. Running through orange farms, enjoy a scenic drive with a view of the Ariake Sea, Unzen. and Shimabara. The view from the rest stops and parking areas located along the road is especially beautiful



Genyama Tenbo Park げんやま展望公園

Located high above the Tensui area, this park has an athletic field and large grass fields. On a clear day, you will see the Ariake Sea, Shimabara Peninsula and even Amakusa Breathe in the relaxing sunset. The park is renowned for its cherry blossoms, azaleas, and hydrangeas that bloom in the spring.



Rengein Tanjoji Okunoin 蓮華院誕生寺奥之院

This is a Shingon Risshu sect Buddhist temple. The "Hiryu-no-Kane", which means flying dragon bell, is the world's largest Bonsho bell that weighs in at 37.5 tons. If you visit the shrine before noon, you might be chosen by the monk to ring the bell with him. The temple is also famous for its autumn foliage.



amada Hiyoshi Shrine (Wisteria Destination

Inside the Shrine grounds is a Japanese wisteria that is believed to be more than 200 years old. Meter long clusters of flowers bloom from mid April to early May. An illumination event is held at night during this season that creates a dreamy atmosphere.

[Using the Audio Guide]

- Receive the device, hang it around your neck, and put on the earphones.
- Press the Start button on the device. The GPS will activate and the audio guide service will begin. Listen to the initial guidance and follow the instructions
- If you see a "Continue" button on the screen when the audio guide plays at a tourist destination, press it to hear more detailed information.
- Audio will play out of the device's speakers if you unplug the earphones.

[Important Information]

O Visitors interested in using the audio guide service should apply at Kanko Hotto Plaza Tamalala.

The applicant must provide identification showing their address, name, and date of birth (e.g. passport, driver's license, or insurance

card, etc.). Your identification will be copied and returned.
